## WARRANTY FOR ACCIDENTAL DAMAGE

All MICHELIN branded agricultural and agro-industrial tyres (Compact Line) purchased after June 1, 2019 have a guarantee against accidental damage. If the tyre is damaged during use and is not repairable, Michelin will bear the cost in accordance with the following conditions

Every Michelin agricultural or agro-industrial Compact Line tyre bearing complete identification numbers, purchased after 01.06.2019, and used in normal conditions and in accordance with the maintenance recommendations and safety precautions of Michelin is covered against accidental damage (accidental localized damage, non-repetitive and not repairable damage caused by impact, sidewall puncture, crown puncture) by the terms and conditions of this warranty in addition to all legal guarantees. Date of purchase is documented by a new equipment sales invoice or by a new tyre purchase invoice. If proof of purchase cannot be documented, the age of the tyre is determined based on its date of manufacture (DOT). This warranty covers tyres purchased from 1st of June 2019 till 31st December 2019. If a tyre examination performed by Michelin shows that a agricultural tyre or agro-industrial Compact Line tyre of the Michelin brand tyre has become unserviceable because of accidental damage, the tyre will be replaced, and the remaining amount payable by the owner will be calculated based on a percentage defined as per the indications in the table above multiplied by the purchase price of a new tyre. The above also applies when the tyre is unmounted. If the tyre is no longer available, it may be replaced with a current Michelin tyre of equivalent size and load and speed index. If an identical replacement tyre does not exist, please contact your Michelin Technical and Sales Representative for more information.

All fitting, delivery and other related fees will be at the expense of the Customer.

This warranty does not cover tyres that have become unserviceable due to:

- using tyres on highly aggressive fields or roads with multiple and repeated aggressions to the tyre crown or sidewall (e.g. on fields with flint);
- inappropriate tyre maintenance;
- inappropriate using conditions such as overload or excessive speed;
- using on inappropriate rims: rims too narrow, damaged or improperly mounted;
- incorrect tyre pressure;
- inappropriate tyre repair;
- accident, fire, chemical corrosion, contamination, tyre alteration or vandalism;
- using the tyre with tyre fillers, sealants, balancing products, ballasting, etc.;
- mechanical maladjustment in the vehicle such as a bad wheel alignment and incorrect mechanical lead;
- climatic factors or ozone effects.
